October 6, 2011 -- The first chamber concert of the 2011-12 Orchestra of the Southern Finger Lakes season features a smaller orchestra conducted by Music Director Toshiyuki Shimada and the orchestra's Principal Horn, Tyler Ogilvie, and Corning resident Jangmin Kug, mezzo soprano. The chamber orchestra concert begins at 7:30 at Christ Episcopal Church, 33 East First Street in Corning. The program includes Corelli's Concerto Gross in D Major, Mozart's Horn Concerto No.2, and Mozart's Symphony No. 29 in A Major.

Tyler Ogilvie, Principal Horn of the Orchestra of the Southern Finger Lakes, is a Long Island native and holds a Bachelor's degree in Music Education and a Master's in Music Performance from Ithaca College. Ogilvie also serves as principal horn of the Utica Symphony and has appeared on stage with several distinguished ensembles including Rhythm and Brass, the Skaneateles Festival Chamber Orchestra, and the Harrisburg Symphony. He has performed in venues such as Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, the National Concert Hall in Dublin, Ireland and Glinka Hall in St. Petersburg, Russia. Ogilvie freelances throughout Central New York and Pennsylvania while teaching Horn Performance studies and Chamber Music at Susquehanna University and Dickinson College.

Originally from Seoul, South Korea, Jangmin Kug graduated with a degree in Voice from Seoul National University then earned her Diploma in Voice from Conservatorio di Milano G. Verdi in Milan, Italy. She made her Operatic debut as Mimi in *La Boheme* at Teatro dell'Erbe in Milan. She taught Italian diction and art songs in JoongAng and Dankook Universities while performing throughout Korea in *Il Barbiere di Siviglia* as Rosina. From there she went to Binghamton, New York to work with Tri-Cities Opera, performing in *Dido and Aeneas*, *Die Zauberflote*, *La Traviata*, *Le Nozze di Figaro*, and *Hansel and Gretel*. Most recently, Ms. Kug sang Laura in *La Gioconda* with Shinjuku Opera in Tokyo.
