The Orchestra of the Southern Finger Lakes, OSFL, will hold auditions on September 14, 2024. **The auditions will consist of prepared solo or concerto and provided list of orchestral excerpts.**

Interested and experienced musicians should provide a one-page résumé and a deposit check for \$50, made payable to Orchestra of the Southern Finger Lakes. Send application materials to the OSFL Office and Orchestra Personnel Manager at the addresses noted below. The application deadline is Friday, September 6, 2024. Once you have applied for an audition, a link to the required excerpts will be sent to you via email. Audition times will be scheduled after the September 6th deadline with information sent to applicants via email shortly thereafter. Checks will be returned on the audition day to those who perform. **Applications will not be considered complete until both resume and check are received**. *Applicants may cancel their audition prior to September 6, without penalty*.

The winner(s) will be ready and willing to perform at the rehearsals and concerts 2, 3, and 4 indicated below for the 2024-25 season beginning with the December dates. The field of candidates will be narrowed by use of résumé if we receive more applicants than we can reasonably hear.
